Those of us with four legs didn't seem to get donuts. What's up with that?






I got to go to this really cool place where the people are all super nice and everything smells really good!

I just thought you should have ALL the details, just since we're old friends and stuff.



I learned that it is my job NOT to speak.








... and sometimes I have absolutely no idea what is going on.
