
Also, in December, I got to attend my friend Cici's graduation. She became a full fledged guide dog. I'm so proud of her and can't wait till that is me on stage.

I also wanted to tell you that I had my first formal evaluation this month and I did great. Have a few things to fine tune, but the trainers said I did great!


Other outings:
