Evening strolls








You can see that I am being set up, in the photos above. Mom likes to drop treats and I have to just ignore them. It is quite hard, but I am getting really good at it!

Back at my moms feet, right where I belong. I sure missed my soft bed, but got quite spoiled in the kennels too.












LAKE ARROWHEAD! Snow zoomies

My first trip to the Village. Walking by people, other dogs, going shopping and settling






I met many weird statues, walked open stairs, rode in the elevator, and practiced my loose leash walking. Mom was so proud of how well I did right out of heat.

Settled on the right side, and I even fell asleep. Wow, mom is proud as settling isn't my favorite thing to do, but I have come so far!




