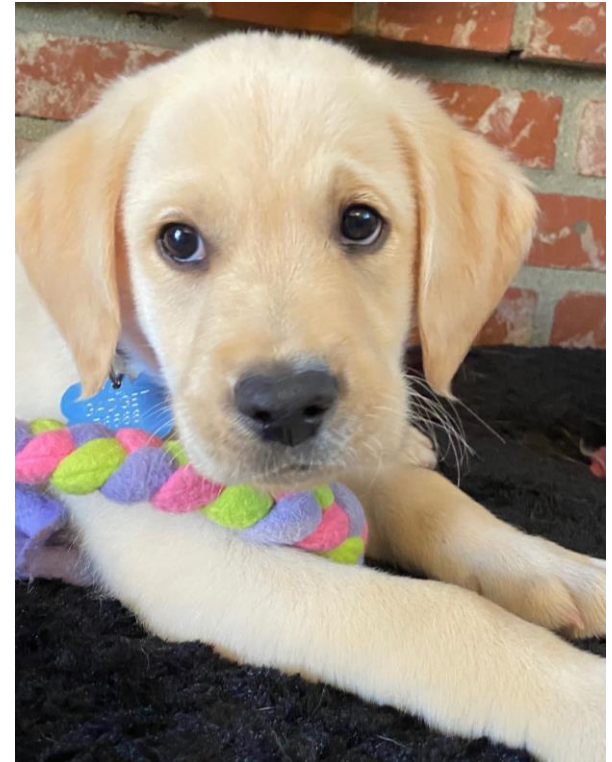


Go Go Gadgets, Great Adventures!

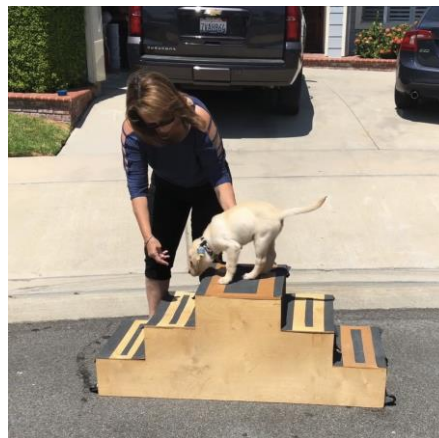
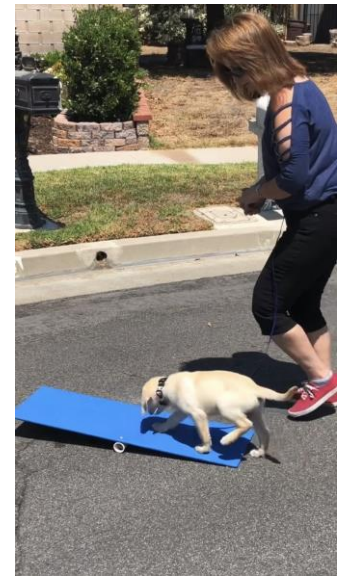
Gadget learning to walk on different textures & uneven surfaces.
