Now that I am growing up, I can take walks in the neighborhood.







I DO TAKE TIME TO SMELL THE FLOWERS

I have to practice all of my basic obedience commands with other dogs trying to distract me. I do a good job of focusing on my handler and paying attention.












I SPENT TIME WITH ANOTHER PUPPY RAISER.

I WENT TO A PUPPY RAISER OUTING.


It's fun to see so many other GDA/TLC puppies. It's also fun to explore new parks and towns.

I practiced my restaurant manners and meeting people by greeting them gently.




IDAHO WAS GREAT.

IT WAS A SNIFF SAFARI!


I didn't see many of the wild animals, but I certainly smelled them. They like to visit the salt lick, and so do I!
