


GRIZZLY CELEBRATES!

I successfully completed another obedience class. This time I had to demonstrate restraint around other dogs, and attention to my handler.




OUTINGS WITH OTHER GDA/TLC PUPPIES








MORE NEW EXPERIENCES IN IDAHO
