



#### HELLO EVERYONE,


IT'S BEEN AN INTERESTING COUPLE OF MONTHS

TRAINING.


I NOW WEIGH 69LBS AND AM PRETTY TALL FOR 8 1/2 MONTHS OLD.




IT'S BEEN NICE BEING ABLE TO GO OUT EVERYWHERE AGAIN. I STILL HAVE LOTS TO LEARN.




