

I LOVE BEING AROUND CHILDREN






CONTINUING SOCIALIZATION

Now that I am over 6 months, I can be exposed to many different sights and sounds so that when I encounter them later so I will be confident and unafraid.


- I thought I was going to greet some people but they were mannequins. They didn't move and ignored me. Im confused.




I GOT TO STAY WITH A PUPPY SITTER


