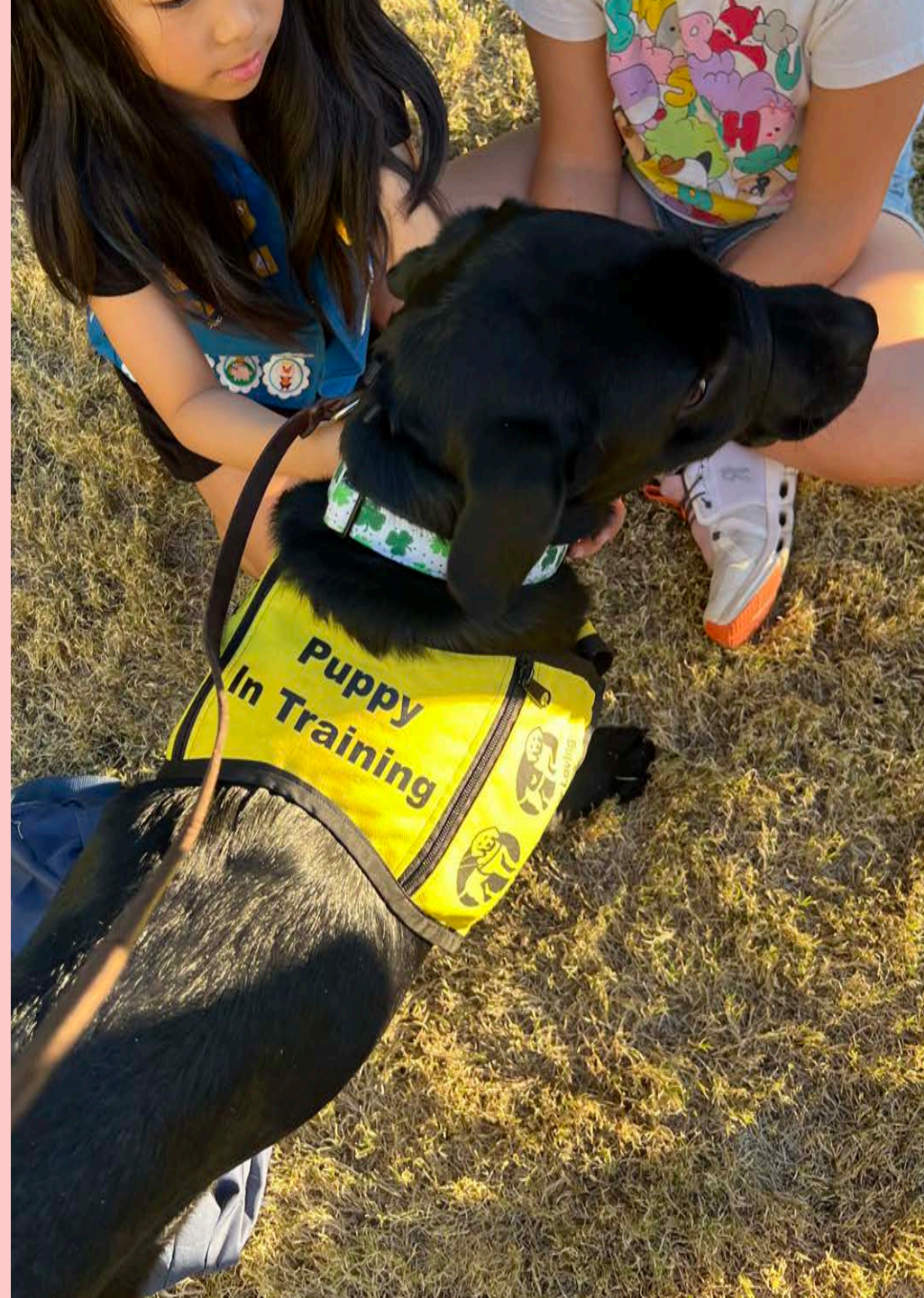
VISITING ANOTHER FAMILY

PUPPY OBEDIENCE CLASS

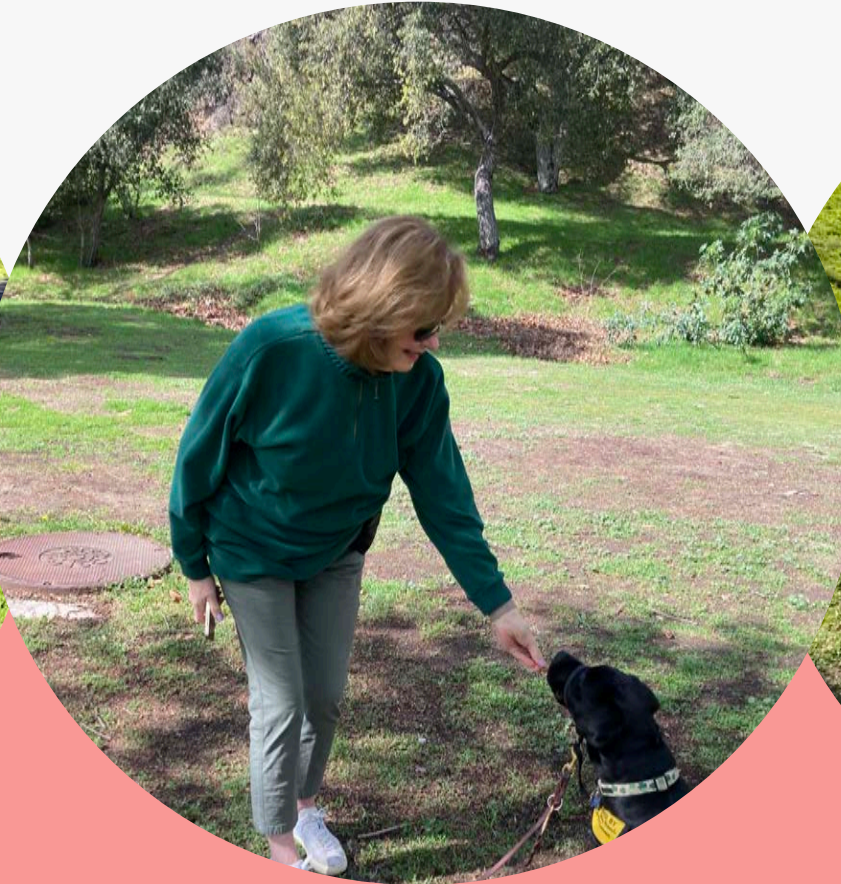

... especially if there are treats!

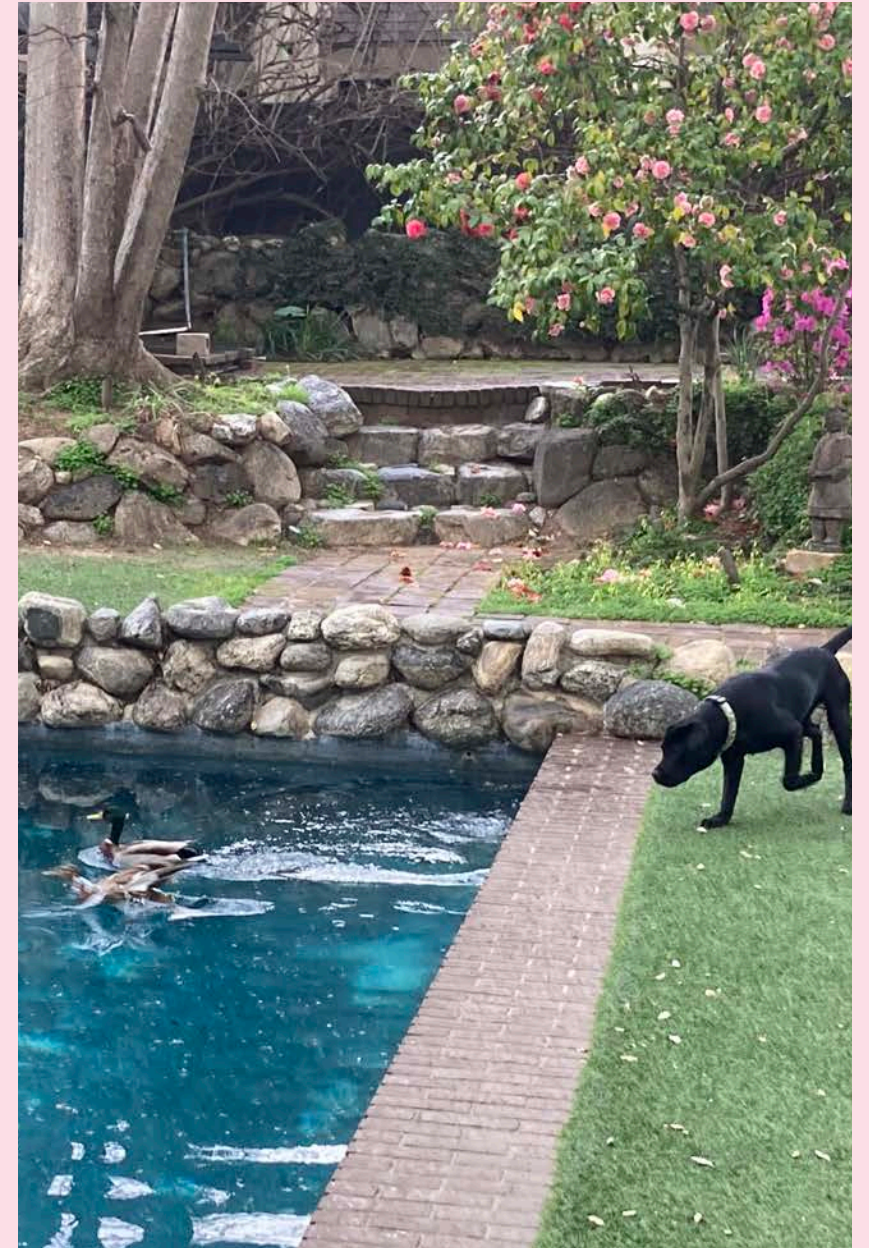


BACKYARD BONUSES



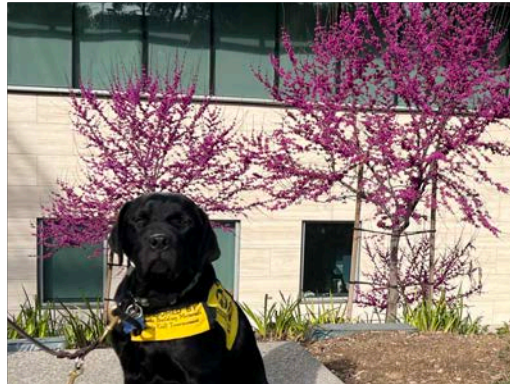
Have I mentioned that I like sticks? The bigger, the better. For some reason, my people won't let me bring them in the house.

I also like ducks. I understand that my ancestors used to like to hunt these guys. I just like to watch them swim in the pool.

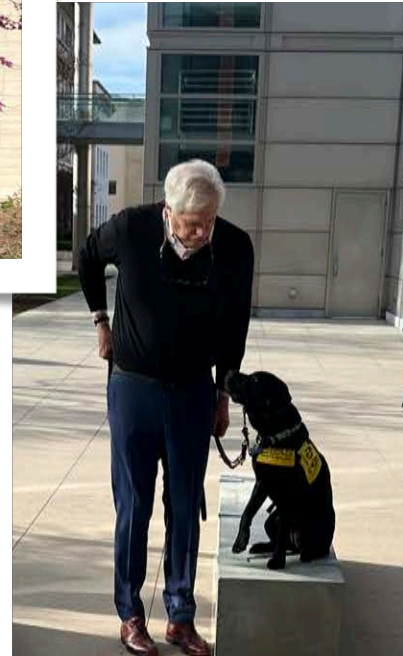


CAMPUS TOURS
