
This is my new friend Hurley. He is a career change friend from GDA. We got to play and I learned some manners on how to play with other dogs. Hurley was very nice to me.






When I can't be outside, I like to find little spots of sun to lay in. I love the way it feels and this is my favorite place to nap!










A new big boy bed appeared one day! I'm so lucky!!!






But to tell you the truth, I still like my baby bed the best!

I like to watch tv sometimes at night to unwind!




I went to a swim meet (look in my sunglasses) with my puppy sitters. I was really good on the pool deck!
