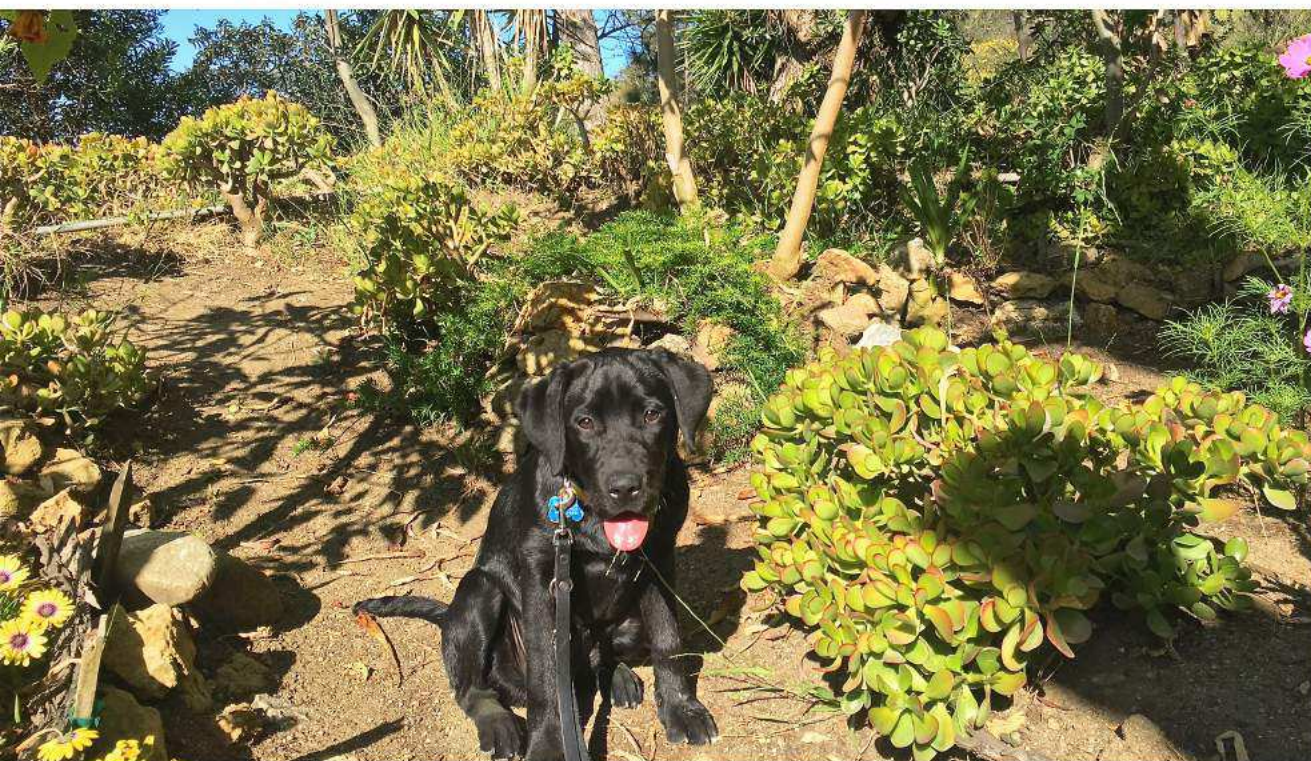

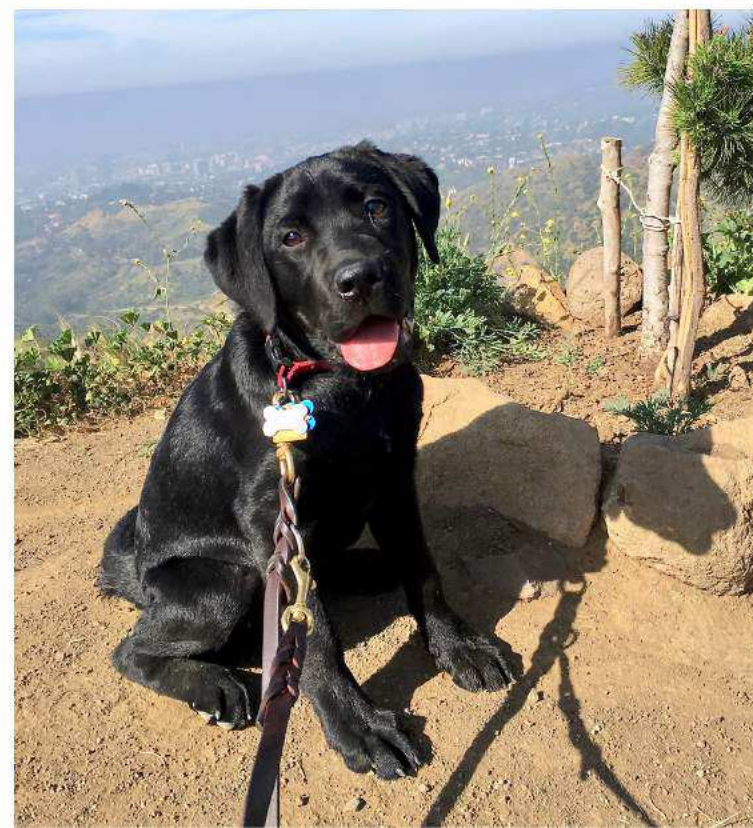
Kerris got tired of my "energy", retreated to the bed.



Sitting under her desk.

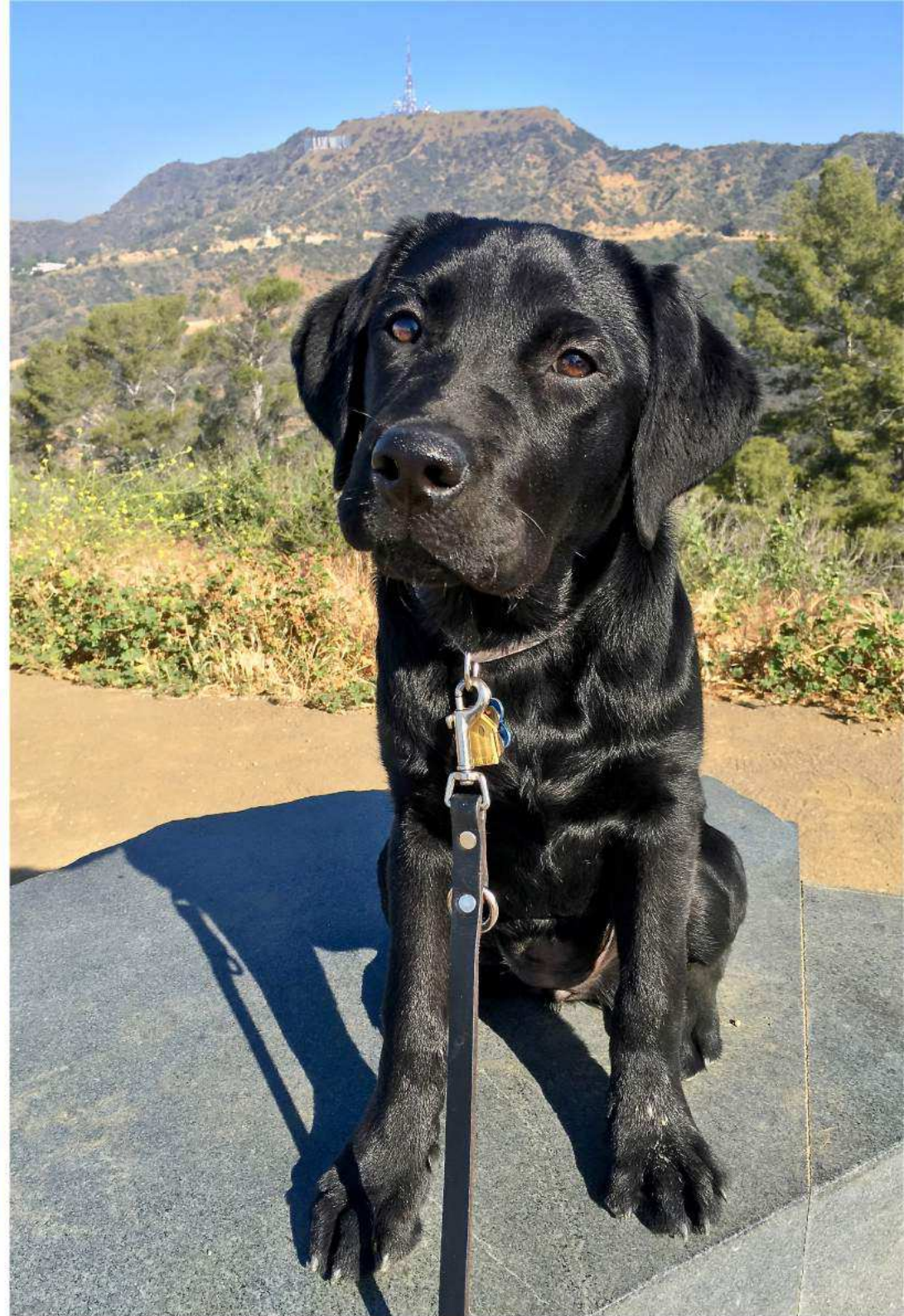


I hike in Griffith Park every morning. This is Dante's View.

5 Months, Exploring and Learning

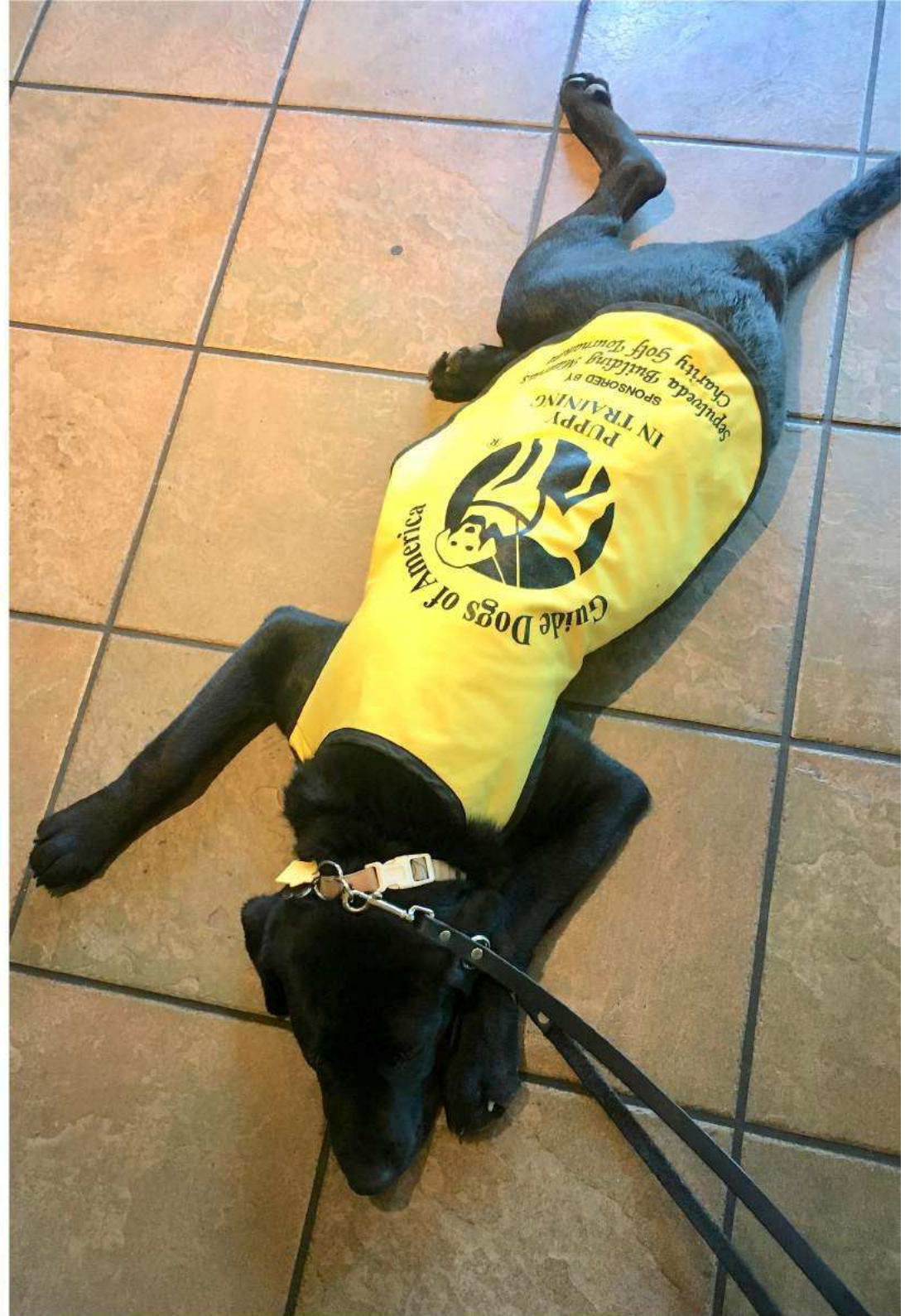

My first visit to the kennel, I am so excited!





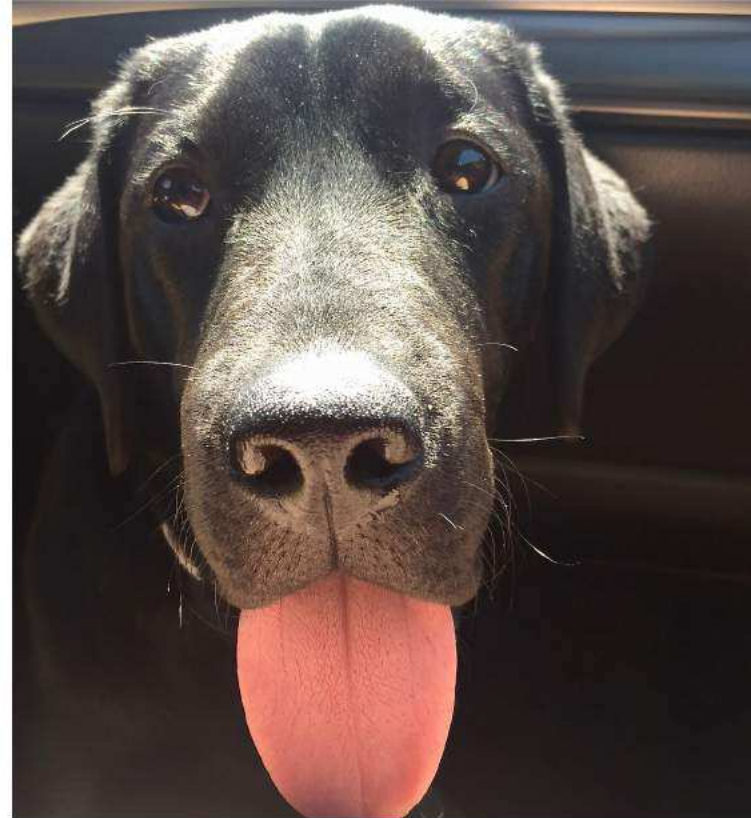
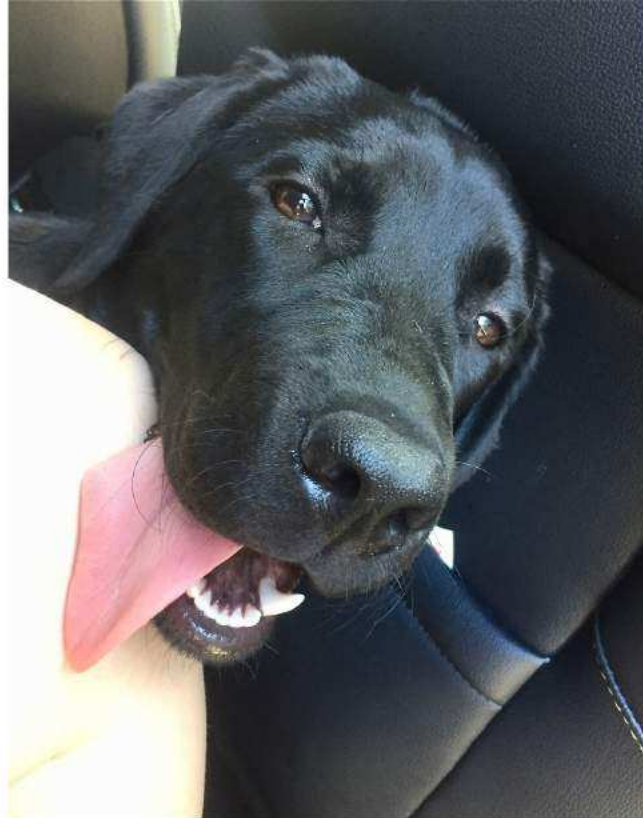

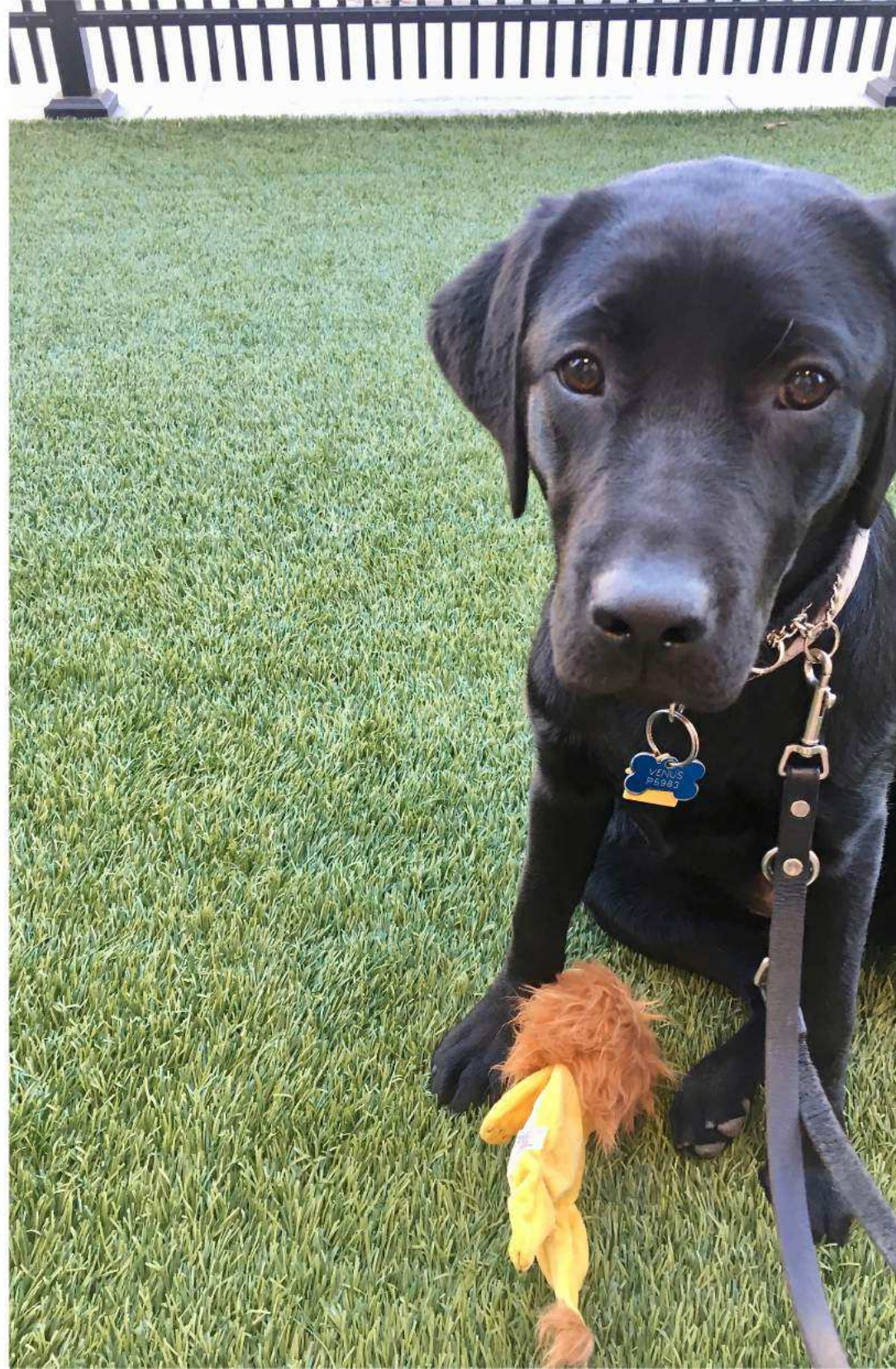
