
Hot off the press... Wagner's pup-dates from April, May and June!

And made new friends...




I met a few other dogs also in the GDA/TLC program...

Pilot to shake, but then we just hugged.






Some-bunny thought this was cute?

I turned 4 months old!!!






So, what exactly does 4 months old look like? Here are a couple of photos comparing the day they brought me home and what happened in just a couple of short months.





On the go...










I get VERY comfortable in MY car! I love riding on the floorboard of the front seat so much that sometimes I don't want to get out.

First dinner out.






First time car shopping!



Had my brothers, Wrigley and Whit, over for a Sunday training and playdate. Can you tell who is who?















Pool party – making a splash in the kiddie pool!

Pickleball puppy – I am learning to settle while my puppy raisers play Pickleball... for hours!




I have to settle when puppy raiser lady does Pilates. Sometimes inside; sometimes outside.

Home and away from home




I've gone on a couple of sleepovers. Essentials were packed.

I turned 6 months!!!





Look at me grow!








