When we get to the office I use the elevator and I now can also use the stairs.

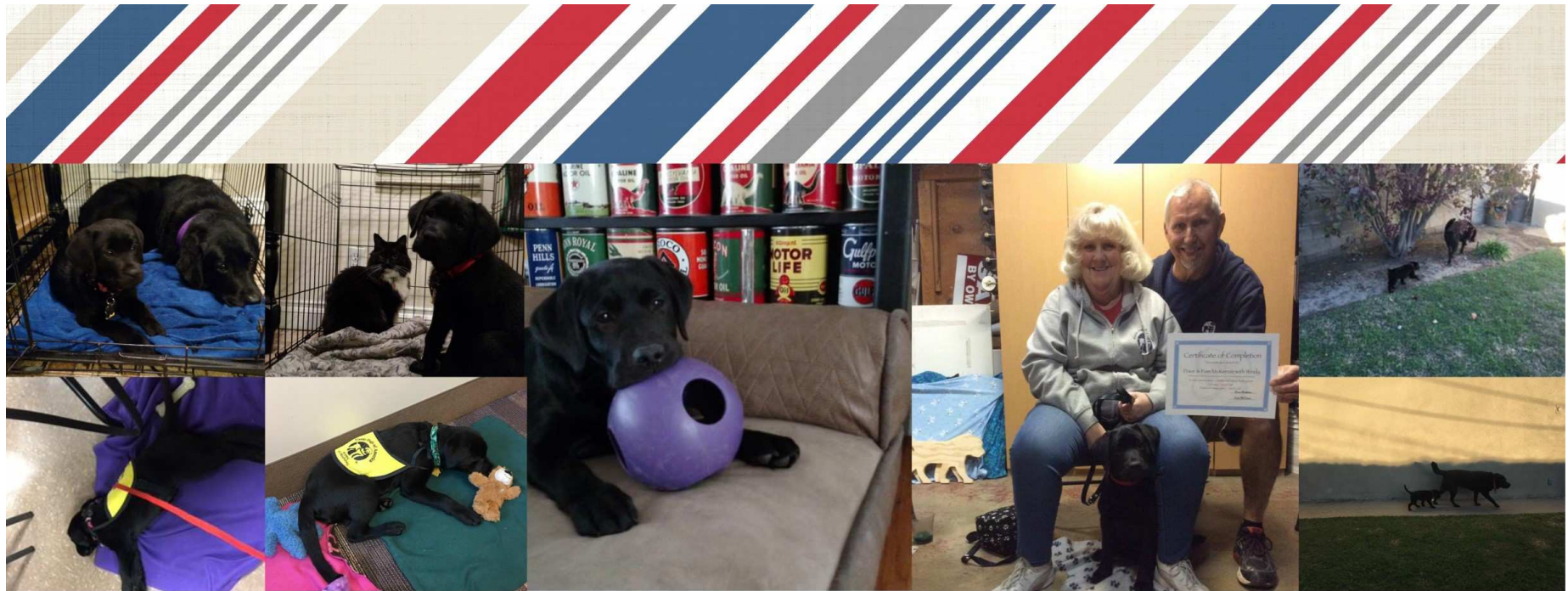
After about 2 hours, Pam and I take a break and walk around the building. Pam has taught me how to "relieve on command" and she tells me I am a very good girl.

Pam says I am doing very well and she is always very happy and gives me lots of praise!





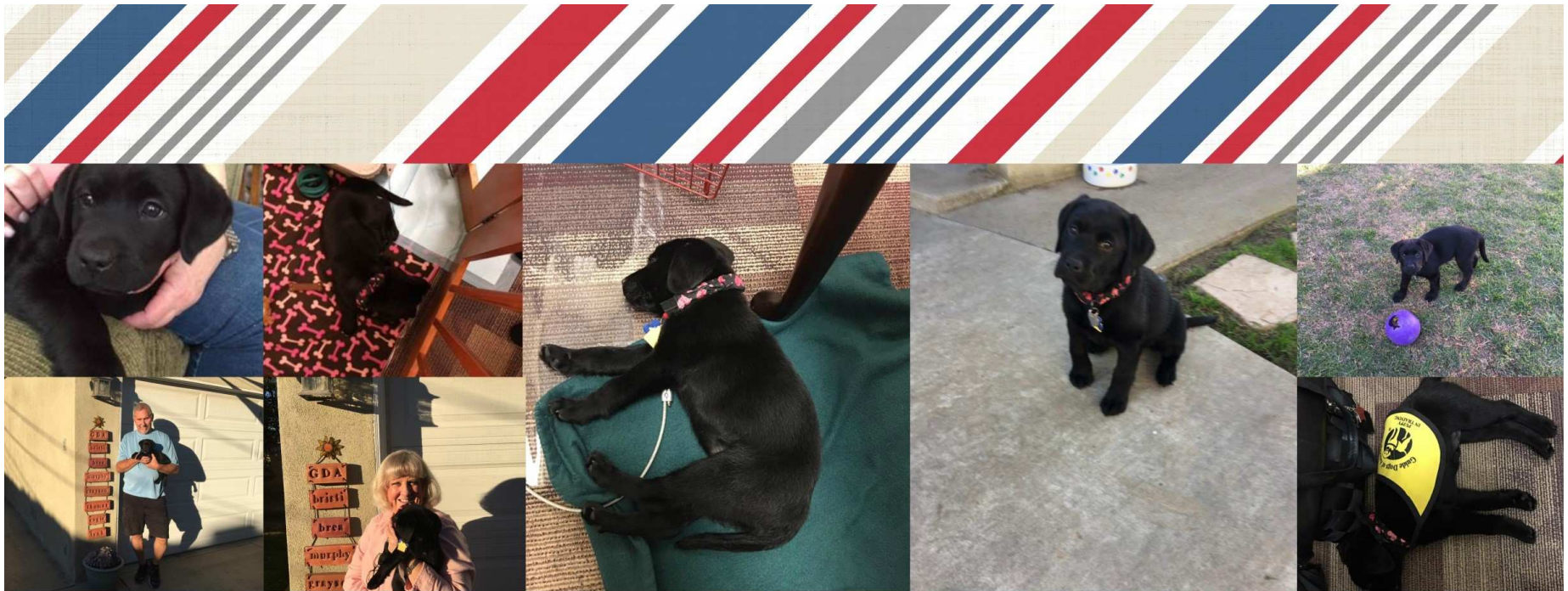
Windy at Play
